Please find a list of events that will lead us to finish out the school year at Viborg-Hurley and recognizing you for all of your accomplishments:

May 14th

- Seniors turn in all school materials and complete final checkout with Mr. Jensen. Front Lobby of the High School 8am – 4pm.

May 16th

- Senior Recognition Video featuring Mr. Jensen & Mr. Mellem will be published on YouTube at 1pm.
- Senior Class Video will be published on YouTube at 1pm. (normally played during graduation)
 - The videos will be posted on Mr. Mellem's YouTube Channel and links will be made available on the school website and school Facebook page.
- Senior Caravan
 - 4:30pm – Meet at the High School (All participating Seniors will participate in both town parades)
 - 5pm - Students will follow firetrucks around the streets of Viborg.
 - The caravan will start on the west side of town and move east. The caravan will only be going down streets that do not have a dead-end and traveling streets running north/south and east/west.
 - Students will be encouraged to drive/ride in their own vehicles and decorate the vehicle.
 - Students may ride with parent(s)/guardian(s).
 - All decorations/music played by students will be school appropriate and directly reflect the expectations of the Viborg-Hurley School District.
 - Mr. Mellem will be following the caravan to help supervise.
 - Starting between 6 - 6:30pm - The caravan will travel to Hurley and begin touring the city of Hurley following the conclusion of the Viborg route.
 - Around 7:00pm - The caravan will conclude at the city park in Hurley.

June 27th

- The Viborg-Hurley School District Graduation Ceremony will take place at 1pm. (tentative date)
- The District is currently planning the ceremony to take place either indoors or outdoors depending on CDC guidelines. During this ceremony, students will be receiving their diplomas and the ceremony will closely resemble, to the best of our ability, a normal graduation ceremony.

Please keep in mind the June graduation date is tentative and could change based upon further guidance from the CDC and State Health Department.
