Dear Parent/Guardian/Students,

We are very proud to say that we are` associated with such a phenomenal School District that cares so much for the students and their learning. When we dismissed school on Tuesday, March 17th, our teachers hit the ground running and started providing instruction to all students at Mound City R-2. Yes, there have been some obstacles and hurdles along the way, but overall the learning has continued and students are getting valuable instruction to help them continue the growing process.

The scheduled last day of school for the 2019-2020 School Year will be Friday, May 15th. Currently we are looking at the week of May 11-15 to allow students back in the building to retrieve their supplies. Mr. Miles and Ms. Flint will put a schedule together and post it on the school website. The elementary teachers will be bagging up each individual desk for their students. Middle School and High School will be similar in which the belongings from their locker will be bagged up and labeled as well. The entire check in process will take place in the gym to limit exposure throughout the entire building. The plan is to organize the times and dates for checkout alphabetical so that larger families do not have to make multiple trips to the building to retrieve supplies. The important part of this process is to limit the number of individuals you bring with you and remember social distancing. We suggest 1 parent per family. Students may see classmates and friends during this time, but social distancing will be enforced. During this time period, we will expect students to turn in their textbooks, chromebooks (if they checked one out), and pick up their bag of supplies from their locker or desk. If the date and time does not work for your student, please contact the appropriate administrator via email (korey.miles@mndcty.org and dee.flint@mndcty.org).

The teachers are grading the work that students have been doing. The grade that the student received during the 3rd quarter stands as it is since 3rd quarter was finished prior to dismissal. The student's 4th Quarter and 2nd Semester grade will be no lower than what they received for 3rd quarter. However, their grade may improve based on their accuracy, effort, and completion of assignments during this time period. It's important to note that on the student's report card, their 4th quarter grade will state that it was determined during COVID-19. The Mound City R-2 School District wants to stress the value of the student's work and the parental/guardian support and time has been greatly appreciated.

We know this has been a trying time for everyone. Our teachers have been working hard to help each and every student, and they also know that each student has different needs. These teachers have gone above and beyond and I'm very thankful for all they have done during this time.
