South Wasco County School District Diploma Requirements July, 2022

A high school diploma will be awarded to students in grades 9 through 12 who:

- Complete a minimum of 26 credits which include at least:
 - 4 English
 - o 3 Math
 - o 3 Science
 - o 3 Social Science
 - o 3 from among Career & Technical Education, World Languages, and the Arts
 - 1 Health
 - 1.5 Physical Education
 - .5 Personal Finance
 - 7 Elective
- Complete and Present an Education Plan and Profile

Designations for the 2 types of South Wasco County Schools Diplomas

South Wasco County Diploma	South Wasco County Honors Diploma
 Earn a GPA of 1.5 or higher Complete 2 job shadows, at least 1 during senior year Participate in 40 hours of qualifying community service Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). A parent waiver is possible after meeting with District staff 	 Earn a GPA of 3.5 or higher Complete 4 job shadows, at least 2 during senior year (can include 2 college visitations) Participate in 60 hours of qualifying community service Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). A parent waiver is possible after meeting with District staff Earn 1.5 credits in advanced coursework (e.g., dual credit, college courses, advanced CTE)

Oregon provides some diploma options at a lower academic standard than South Wasco County Schools (e.g., 24 credits, .86 GPA). These options may be made available to some students either due to identified disabilities or other factors that interfere with a students ability to meet the South Wasco standards. Staff and families will need to meet to determine if one of these Oregon diploma options best fits an individual student's needs.
