# Rock Flowers



## A note from Mrs. Barnes

To honor the 2020 COVID 19 - Spring of Distance Learning, the Easton School Department would like to decorate the school grounds with "Rock Flowers". We are asking our school families to create "Rock Flowers".

How do you create a "Rock Flower"?

- Go for a walk where rocks hang out.
- Look for 4-6 rocks that would make a flower that would measure approximately 6-15 inches in diameter.
- Each rock should be fairly flat and no bigger or heavier than what you can hold in your hand.
- Wash your rock, a clean rock will be easier to paint.
- Paint each rock entirely with acrylic paint or nail polish. If you do not have paint or nail polish please email Mrs. Barnes at [Jill.barnes@eastonschools.org](mailto:Jill.barnes@eastonschools.org) or call the Elementary School at 488-7701. We will get the paint to you through meal delivery or other arrangements.
- After rocks have fully dried, please place them into a box or other secure container.
- Enclose a slip of paper with the name of students/family creating the rock flower.
- Finished rocks may be dropped off at the school during packet pick day up May 6, or meal pick up days May 7, 11, 14 or 18. If you can not deliver the rock flower to the school please notify the school at 488-7701 for other arrangements.
- We would like to have the "Rock Flower" project done by the week of May 18.

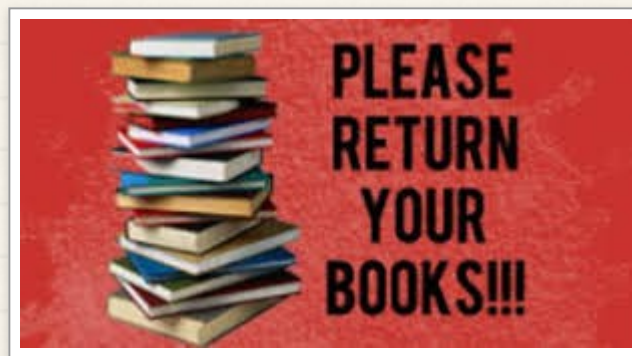
# PreK and Kindergarten Registration
