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LONG TERM DRIVING & PARKING PRIVILEGES

- 1. Students are reminded that driving a vehicle to school and parking on the Sanford campus is a privilege that is extended to Juniors and Seniors who are good citizens and are in good standing with the school. This privilege is maintained by exercising caution and prudence in the operation of vehicles on campus.
- 2. For the safety of all concerned, the following regulations are in effect:
 - a. Observe 5 MPH speed limit on campus. Speeding, unsafe driving, tire and/ or excessive exhaust or engine noise is not permitted and will result in loss of driving privileges indefinitely.
 - b. Park only in the student parking lots. Do not park in the faculty, visitor or handicap spaces. If you need clarification on where these areas are please ask. Do not park in the STEM area without office permission.
 - c. Student vehicles may not be driven off campus during the school day without permission from the main office. Students are not to linger or gather in the parking areas before or after their session.
 - d. Students are not permitted to be in or around vehicles during the day. No passengers are allowed ever.
 - e. Sanford High School student parking tags must be hanging on your rearview mirror at all times.
 - f. If you drive another household vehicle or new vehicle, you must display the parking tag issued to you and report the use of the new car, make, model, plate number, to the SRTC office **the day** you drive the different vehicle.
 - g. Violation of these regulations will result in disciplinary action including the restrictions or loss of on-campus vehicle privileges.
 - h. If driving for employment after school, you must fill out the employment verification form and be approved, **before** driving to SRTC.
- 3. The administration can/will remove parking privileges for disciplinary reasons at their discretion.
- 4. Students must present a copy of the vehicle's registrations. The vehicle must have a valid inspection sticker.
- 5. Student permits are non transferable. Violations will result in loss of permit. Vehicles inappropriately parked will be ticketed at student/owner's expense.
- 6. See Student Handbook for additional information and parking map. Incomplete forms will be denied.
