Maine Revised Statute 20-A M.S.R. § 4701-B requires school administrative units to screen students in kindergarten through second grade who have difficulty in these areas phonological and phonemic awareness, soundsymbol recognition, alphabet knowledge, decoding skills, rapid naming skills, encoding skills.


