Why are we screening

Maine Dyslexia Screening Project 2022-2023

Maine Revised Statute 20-A M.S.R. § 4701-B requires school administrative units to screen students in kindergarten through second grade who have difficulty in these areas phonological and phonemic awareness, sound-symbol recognition, alphabet knowledge, decoding skills, rapid naming skills, encoding skills.

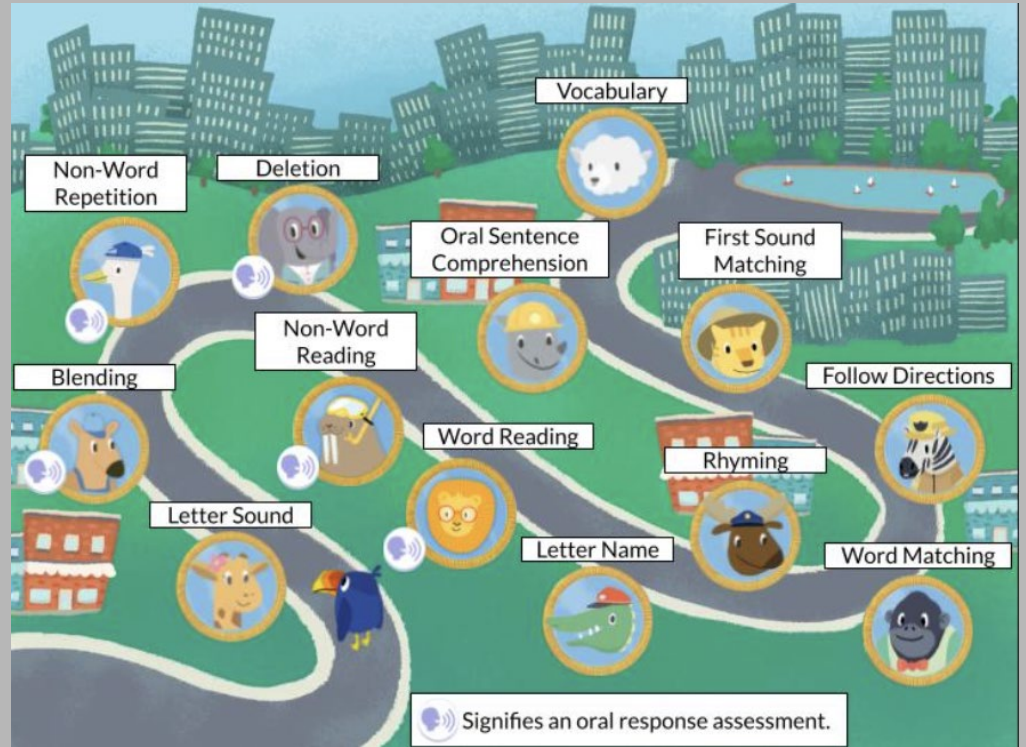
Committee

- Decided Early Bird was best fit for our students

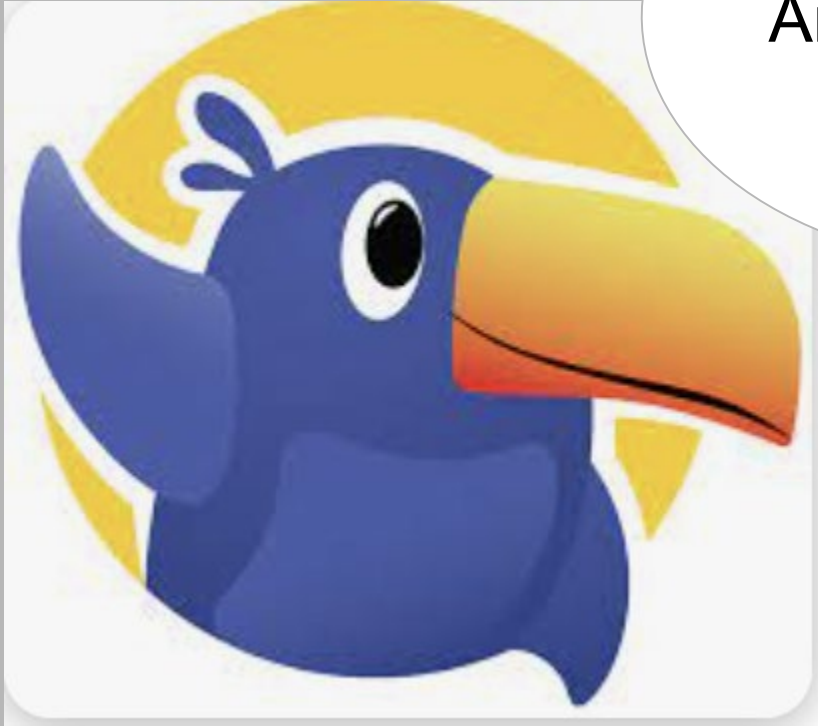


- K screener takes about 45 minutes
- Grade 1 screener takes about 30 minutes
- Assessment is supposed to be done 3 times each year
- Game based assessment

- March - Followup training to look at reports, next steps and interventions
