Noble High School Graduation 2020 Guidelines

1. All vehicles will enter off of 48th and will be directed to the south end of the parking lot to begin lining up. Security will direct you as to where to park. The Northeast entry to the HS Parking Lot will open at 6:00 p.m. We encourage you to pay attention to the facility limitations and plan accordingly. Please do not arrive before 6:00 p.m. as there will be no parking available.
2. All school rules of conduct will be enforced. As always, the use of tobacco, alcohol and drugs are prohibited on campus.
3. Graduates and family members must remain in their vehicles at all times. Graduates will be directed as to when to exit the vehicle for their personal diploma presentation. Graduates should be sitting by the passenger side window to allow for easy exiting.
4. A professional photographer has been hired and NPS will purchase every graduate a graduation photograph. We plan to include these pictures in their Senior Packets.
5. With our ceremony being conducted outside and not knowing how the weather might be, we ask that you dress appropriately for your picture. Decorations on the Cap and Gown are not allowed. Footwear is our most pressing concern and we recommend that flat shoes be worn. Flip flops are discouraged as they may present a trip hazard.
6. After each graduate has received their diploma, they are to return to their vehicle, and return to their parking spot for the remainder of the ceremony.
7. No buses or trailers will be allowed in the parking lot. We understand that due to the limitations on one vehicle per family, some families will want to use larger vehicles. Due to the CDC and Social Distancing Guidelines, we will require all oversize vehicles to be placed at the end of rows to allow for ease entering and exiting the ceremony.
8. At the conclusion of the pronouncement of graduates, we ask that you remain in your vehicles for the special finale celebration.
9. When all activities have been completed at the HS, Law Enforcement will lead all graduates in a celebration parade. We will exit north on 48th and will follow the lead of our officers. We will continue westbound on Post Oak to Highway 77 South. We will continue south to Maguire Road where the parade will end.
10. Due to CDC and SDE guidelines, we are unable to have any of our facilities open which include restrooms. Please insure all needs have been addressed before arriving at Noble High School.

12. Please follow the directions of law enforcement personnel and parking lot attendants as we conduct our graduation in a safe and professional manner, and within all CDC guidelines.
13. Graduates are asked to maintain their caps, gowns and tassels in great condition as we continue to hold out hope for a traditional ceremony at a later time in the summer should conditions allow. We will continue to follow all guidelines from the SDE, State of Oklahoma and the CDC.
14. In case of Inclement Weather, the graduation ceremony will be held on Wednesday, May 20, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

No vehicles other than ones for the graduates, and school administration, will be allowed on campus. We hope that our families, teachers, and community members understand this situation and support our efforts to honor our Noble High School Class of 2020.
