

Parents and Guardians of Students in Grades K-11:

While students in grades 5-11 are used to being able to keep their devices over the summer, East Noble elementary students in grades K-4 have never had this opportunity. Due to the unusual circumstances surrounding the ending of this school year, **East Noble has decided to let ALL STUDENTS IN GRADES K-11 keep their devices over the summer!**

Here are a few details regarding students keeping their iPads and Laptops:

- **FOURTH GRADERS:** Students going from fourth to fifth grade will keep their iPads over the summer; when school resumes in the fall, the iPad will be swapped out for the student's new device, a Yoga 11e Lenovo laptop.
- **EIGHTH GRADERS:** Students going from eighth grade to ninth grade will keep their current Lenovo devices over the summer; when school resumes in the fall, the current device will be swapped out for the student's new freshman device.
- **EIGHTH GRADE LAPTOP PURCHASE:** Eighth grade students will still have the opportunity to purchase their current device for \$30. Please be on the lookout for an email later today regarding this process. Eighth grade students purchasing their laptops will still need to return them in the fall in order to have the hard drive changed and to be able to receive their new laptops.
- **SUPPORT**
  - Laptop/iPad support will be available throughout the summer by calling (260)347-7180 extension 0 and scheduling a time to bring the device in.
  - Students may also email [techsupport@eastnoble.net](mailto:techsupport@eastnoble.net) for technology assistance over the summer.
- **SUMMER WITHDRAWALS:** Families who decide to withdraw from East Noble School Corporation during the summer **MUST** return their child's device to East Noble High School. Please call (260)347-7180 ext. 0 to schedule a time to drop the device off. Families leaving the corporation and not returning iPads or laptops will be charged the full replacement cost of the devices should they not be returned.
- **WEB FILTERING ALERTS:** Any student who performs inappropriate web searches over the summer and triggers web filtering alerts will have their accounts disabled for the duration of the summer.

**Help us ensure the success of this initiative by being vigilant in the care of your child's school devices this summer. Store them in safe places, continue to run updates weekly, monitor your child's use, and remember to contact the East Noble Technology Department to schedule a support appointment should the device become damaged or broken.**
