Minutes from 10/3/19 Meeting

1. Slice Committee reported out their findings on students getting credit for core classes at BOCES:
 - 30 juniors – Math
 - 18 seniors – Math
 - 41 seniors – ELA – 9 are taking it here
 - 56 juniors – Science
 - 41 seniors – Science

There are 67 juniors at BOCES this year

Committee feels the curriculum at BOCES is weak and won't prepare students for careers & college. We wouldn't need to hire any more teachers if we require students to take their classes here.

For some students it wouldn't fit in their schedule, it would negatively impact electives and foreign language. Students who are getting Math, Science, ELA at BOCES are able to take more classes here (band, business, tech, foreign language, chorus, art, etc...)

Other schools that replied to a list serv: most allow students to do what we do. Some only allow it if they can't fit it into their schedule.

Further discussion/investigation will be done on this topic.
