New Business

1. TMS/HS School Vulnerability Assessment - based on a Vulnerability Assessment conducted in the Fall of 2016 the following bullets are areas that were identified as needs with possible solutions.

- Should there be a security guard at the High School (Door 1) entrance? Instead of 2 security personnel at the main entrance in the morning
- Students in the building between 7-7:20 in the building unsupervised
  - Options - more supervision at 7AM or student lock out until a specific time
- Adult supervision by the bus loop and Door 1 upon student arrival
  - Suggestion - police patrol at student drop off to combat parents dropping off in the “no stop” zones/Police Blitz
  - Possibly paint lines, or switch bus loop and parent loop at arrival
- Equip key personnel with a panic button in case of emergency
- Can all interested staff receive CPR training during a staff development
