Dear Trailblazer Families,

As we conclude the 2019-2020 school year, it certainly is safe to say it will be one to remember! So that our students can get their personal belongings and report cards from their classrooms, we will be opening the building on the following dates and times with strict guidelines in place to help protect all stakeholders. During these times **ONLY**, students will be allowed in the building to help maintain the suggested social distancing guidelines based upon square footages.

- **Tuesday, May 19 from 2:00-6:00—ONLY those families whose oldest student’s last name begins with letters A-F**
- **Wednesday, May 20 from 2:00-6:00 —ONLY those families whose oldest student’s last name begins with letters G-M**
- **Thursday, May 21 from 2:00-6:00 —ONLY those families whose oldest student’s last name begins with letters N-Z**

We will be monitoring the number of students entering the building. Students may be required to wait outside on designated spots on the sidewalk until other students exit the building.

All East Noble Schools will be strictly following these guidelines to help protect the safety of all involved:

- **ONLY** students will be allowed into the building
 - All students will enter through door 2 and exit through door 1. After student drop off you will be directed to continue down the line or take a parking spot.
 - We ask that parents remain in a car line along the school sidewalk unless directed to take a parking space. Students will be directed back to cars in the line on the sidewalk or assisted to cross to the parking lot.
 - Hand sanitizer stations will be available upon entering and exiting the building.
- Students will need to bring a bag for their belongings (we will have extras on hand.)
- No physical contact between students and staff will be allowed.
- Areas will be set up for the return of library books or school owned property.
 - **If you will not be returning to ENSC in the fall, please bring in laptops or iPads and the charger provided to you by the school.**
- Teachers will be present in their classrooms to assist students.
- Staff will be in hallways to help keep students moving and maintain social distancing.
- Bathrooms and drinking fountains will NOT be available during this time.
- All Staff will be wearing masks to help protect our students. While not required for students, it is highly recommended that they too wear masks.

Given the guidelines from the Governor’s office, we believe that this brings some closure for us as a staff and our students.
