



# Seneca Grade School

## Medical and Health Information 2021-2022

### ***The Illinois State Law requires the following:***

**-Physical examinations and current immunizations** are required for students entering *preschool, kindergarten and sixth grade* or those new to an Illinois school. The examination must have taken place on or after one year prior to the first day of school.

**-Dental examinations** are required for students entering *kindergarten, second grade and sixth grade* or those new to an Illinois school. The examination must have taken place on or after November 15, 2020 for the 2021-22 school year.

**-Eye examinations** are required for students entering *kindergarten* or those new to Illinois schools. The examination must have taken place within 1 year prior to the 2021-22 school year.

**We ask that these be completed no later than the first day of school attendance. State Law says that students without these exams and/or vaccinations are to be excluded from school.**

-Please fill out a **Yearly Health Information** sheet for each child attending Seneca Grade School in the 2021-22 school year. This information is shared with the teachers and staff that work with your child.

-If your child is required to take any type of medication while at school (over the counter medications or medications ordered by the doctor) then a **Medication Authorization Form** must be completed. In order for this medication to be administered **the form must be signed by your child's physician and the parent or legal guardian.**
