ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET HEARING AND VOTE

Notice is hereby given that inhabitants of the Greenville Central School District qualified to vote at the School Meeting in said District will vote on all business by absentee ballot, as per New York State Governor's Executive Order 202.26. The school will be mailing absentee ballots through the US Postal Service to every registered voter in the District on May 18, 2020. If you do not receive a ballot and are a qualified voter who has registered, you may obtain an absentee ballot by emailing Daphane Pearson at pearsond@greenvillecsd.org. The date of the 2020-2021 Budget Vote and Board of Election is June 9, 2020 and absentee ballots are due by 5:00 PM on this date.

Notice is hereby given that the Annual Budget Hearing will take place online using YouTube on Thursday, May 28, 2020 @ 6:30 PM for presentation of the 2020-2021 proposed budget. Refer to the Greenville CSD website for the link.

Notice is also given that a copy of the statement of the amount of moneys which will be required for the ensuing year for school purposes, exclusive of public moneys, and a copy of a tax exemption report may be obtained by taxpayers during the fourteen (14) days immediately preceding the June 9, 2020 Annual Vote in the District by visiting the District website at www.greenvillecsd.org.

Notice is also given that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education must be filed with the District Clerk not later than 5:00 PM on Monday, May 11, 2020.

The following vacancies are to be filled on the Board of Education:

One (1) seat for Michael McAneny for a three (3) year term expiring June 30, 2023

One (1) seat for Duncan Macpherson for a three (3) year term expiring June 30, 2023

A petition is required to nominate a candidate to the office of member of the Board of Education. Each petition must be directed to the District Clerk and must state the name and residence of the candidate. The minimum threshold of signatures required has been eliminated per the Governor's Executive Order 202.26. Blank nominating petitions may be obtained by emailing Daphane Pearson at pearsond@greenvillecsd.org and must be submitted to the District Clerk at the District Office by Monday, May 11, 2020 no later than 5:00 PM.

A voter personal registration day will be held on Wednesday, May 27, 2020 between the hours of 3:00 PM and 7:00 PM in the elevator lobby of the Scott M. Ellis Elementary School. Social Distancing rules will apply. Qualified voters may also register to vote by contacting the County Board of Elections by mail, or registering remotely through the New York State Department of Motor Vehicle's website at <https://dmv.ny.gov/more-info/electronic-voter-registration-application>.

Notice is also given that the following resolutions will be voted on:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Greenville Central School District be authorized to increase by \$700, for a total of \$42,700, to the amount to be raised by tax for the support of the Greenville Public Library.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Greenville Central School District be authorized to increase by \$1,126, for a total of \$27,642, to the amount to be raised by tax for the support of the Rensselaerville Public Library.
