Parent Pickup Plan – Monday, May 18th – Wednesday May 20th, 2020

Dear Truman Tribe,

This week the teachers and I are working to prepare your child/ren's belongings for pickup schedule for May 18th-20th. We would like to share our district approved plan for parent pickup of student belongings. **The Pickup Day and hours vary based on last name.** Due to our large number of families, we need to stagger pickup times based on family Last Name. These are the timeframes: 5/18

- 8:30-10:30 AM: Families with Last Names beginning with A, B, or C (47 families)
- 11:00-1:30 PM: Families with Last Names beginning with D, E, or F (31 families)
- 2:00-4:30 PM: Families with Last Names beginning with G, H, or I (25 families)

5/19

- 8:30-10:30 AM: Families with Last Names beginning with J, K, or L (12 families)
- 11:00-1:30 PM: Families with Last Names beginning with M, N or O (33 families)
- 2:00-4:30 PM: Families with Last Names beginning with P, Q, or R (29 families)

5/20

- 8:30-10:30 AM: Families with Last Names beginning with S, T, U, or V (50 families)
- 11:00-1:30 PM: Families with Last Names beginning with W, X, Y or Z (13 families)

When arriving at on your designated day, during your timeframe, please follow these guidelines:

- 1. As you enter we will be greeting you and directing you to pull around to our side doors. Please drive slow and follow the signs to create a car line through our process.
- 2. The first set of doors will be to collect any belongings you need to return to school. (Ex. Library books, teacher materials or books)
 - We will hold a trash bag up to your window to allow you to drop any belongings into the bag.
 - We will seal the bag and label it for it to be returned after it safely quarantines for a period of time.
 - We will ask for your student name, grade and teacher at this time as well!
- 3. We will then have you head to the cafeteria doors. We will have two doors (drive thru style) where you will be collecting student belongings.
 - We will bring the bag of belongings to your car and hand to you through the window
- 4. There will be no human-to-human contact, but lots of waving, well wishes and smiles! A few things to keep in mind:
 - Please remain patient throughout this process and we will do our best to keep the Car Line moving smoothly.
 - If, upon returning home, you find someone else's belongings mixed in with your child's, please let principal know: I will do my best to find a solution.
 - If you are unable to come during your assigned time, please let me know.
 - We currently have all items in the Truman Lost and Found bagged up. Therefore, if you find
 yourself missing a belonging, please let me know the description and I will do my best to
 retrieve it.
