- Online Schooling Remainder of the Year- As all of you know, the West Valley School Board voted unanimously to stay with online learning the remainder of the school year. This was a difficult decision, but centered on what was safest and best for everyone. The schooling will continue through May 29. June will be the time for students to catch up on work and pick up their personal belongings, as well as, bring back Chromebooks and other school materials. The official last of school is still June 10.
- Picking up Personal Belongings and Returning School Materials Mrs. Blair, Mr.
  Gross and Mr. Wilson will be setting up schedules for families to pick up students'
  personal items at school. During that same time, Mr. Wilson will be making
  arrangements for the return of any Chromebooks that were borrowed from the school.
  They will be sending out schedules for this closer to the end of May. We will need to
  follow the CDC guidelines for social distancing, so please be aware of the directions
  from the principals.
- 8th Grade Completion Ceremony- We all agree the 8th grade completion ceremony is one of the highlights of the year for 8th grade students. It's a special time in their lives, as they leave something familiar behind and head into a brand new adventure. This year, due to restrictions and uncertainty around Covid-19, we will not have an event on campus. The class will share in the creation of a video which will be released on the planned ceremony date of June 9. Promotion certificates will be printed and given to

- students via a special staff delivery. We hope that you carry on the tradition of celebrating this milestone by doing something special with your 8th grader.
