Dear Community Members and Employees:

Beginning today anyone who enters Springport Public Schools campuses and buildings “must adopt social distancing practices and other mitigating measures” in accordance with Governor Whitmer’s Executive Order 2020-70 to protect themselves and others from transmitting and receiving the COVID-19 virus.

Mitigating measures includes (but is not limited to)”a daily entry screening protocol for workers, contractors, suppliers, and any other individuals entering a worksite, including a questionnaire covering symptoms and suspected or confirmed exposure to people with possible COVID-19, together with, if possible, a temperature screening”; limiting the number of people gathered in one place; wearing a face mask; regular cleaning and disinfecting; and wearing disposable gloves when necessary to perform a function related to “critical infrastructure” work and conducting basic operations.

Critical infrastructure workers conduct basic operations related to sustaining or protecting life and “are those whose in-person presence is strictly necessary to allow the business or operation to maintain the value of inventory and equipment, care for animals, ensure security, process transactions (including payroll and employee benefits), or facilitate the ability of employees to work remotely.” Central Office; Custodial and Maintenance; Food Service; Transportation; Agriscience and FFA Staff are all Critical Infrastructure Workers for Springport Public Schools.
