At this time, we are looking to follow as close to the school calendar as possible. I will keep you posted as we receive continued guidance from the Maine Department of Education and the CDC. We appreciate all of your support while you and your children are adjusting to being “home-schooled” for this length of time. We will continue to provide work packets for skill building and review. Tomorrow, May 11, 2020 will be the next packet deliveries/pickups. The time for pickups is from **9:00-11:00 am**.

For all packet deliveries, **PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS:**

***If you are on the pickup list for meals, your packet is already put aside for pickup. You do not need to do anything differently than you have in the past.**

***If you are NOT on the pickup list for meals, your packet is already put aside for bus delivery. If you would like to pick up your packet(s), please contact me via email BEFORE 7:00 am on Monday morning because I print the lists at this time. Your packet will be delivered on Monday or on Wednesday of this week.**

Also, we still have gift cards for Hannaford (one per family worth \$25.00). These were donated and you can pick one up when you pick up meals and/or packets. You will just need to sign for it.

We will have two more work packet deliveries/pickups on Wednesday, May 27th and Monday, June 8th. We will continue to provide meals on Mondays and Wednesdays with a possible change during the week of Memorial Day.
