- Applicant must be graduates or candidates for graduation from Wilson High School.
- Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above.
- Complete one-page, double spaced essay, "Why do you want to further your education?"
- If the applicants are college students, they must be progressively working toward a degree.
- Consideration shall be given to high school applicants pursuing a course of study.
- If the applicants are college students, they must be progressively working toward a degree. Consideration shall be given to both high school and college applicants if sufficient funds are available.

Application Deadline:

Scholarship applications can be asked for from the Wilson School Counselor. The application deadline is March 31. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. We recommend you send your application and all supporting documents to us in one envelope. Please be sure to mark each item with your name.
