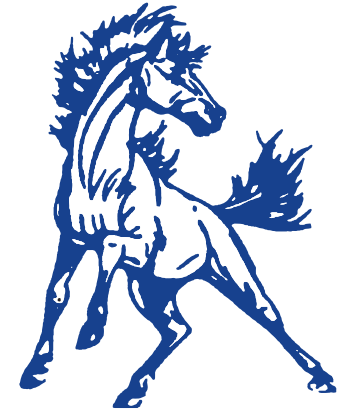

To prepare students with the knowledge and skills necessary for continued education and, ultimately, a successful career in architecture, construction, and skilled mechanical trades occupations. In this pathway a student can choose the construction or design strand.

WHAT IS CTE?

CTE stands for Career & Technical Education. CTE classes include hands on classes in various pathways. A pathway simply focuses on one area. Wabaunsee High School offers six pathways. For each pathway the first course taken should be the introductory level course. These are designated by a 9th grade level course. After the introductory course a student will be able to take a technical level courses. A technical level course gives a deeper understanding of the subject area. The last level of classes is called the application level. In this level students are able to apply what has been learned in real-world applications. CTE also can help all students achieve the objectives of the Kansas College and Career Ready Standards (KCCRS) through authentic, applied learning experiences.

Pathways are designed to provide a smooth transition from high school to postsecondary education (technical colleges, community colleges and universities), apprenticeship opportunities, the military, and/or the workplace.
