HST Building Presentation Mr. Zachary Brem, third grade teacher Mrs. Jennifer Judd, and

analysis requires.

TL2020 Update Mr. Zac Brem reviewed the MTSS Cohort and in particular the SAEBRS tool for use in universal student screening for behavior

and emotional risk. He also shared HST's next steps. Mrs. Grace

Hartman then reviewed WSEs MTSS Integration.

Mrs. Kelly Pauiling shared information about decodable text called Geodes being used in the classroom which aligns perfectly to Fundations. The HST Intervention teachers will be

piloting the use of these resources.

include looking at assessments and making sure they line up

with skills.
