TONA 2020 - All Stakeholders - One Voice

- Wendel Presentation Brian Brady, architect, presented an overview of one elementary campus grades pre K-5.
- Transportation Mr. Kirisits Gave a breakdown of students who reside in the Mullen and Riverview areas. He listed the total number of elementary students that would be in one campus (754) K 12. He did not list pre-k because they are not provided school transportation. The total number of walkers listed was 154 to one elementary campus at Fletcher. The total number of students that will need to be bussed to the one elementary campus was listed at 600. The total number of busses would not be reduced by going to one elementary campus. Mr. Kirisits provided a spreadsheet handout to the committee.

 - Debt Ceiling 5% of the full valuation of the tax value \$627,000,000 \$31,356,371 (10%) \$20,000,000 in outstanding debt can only borrow \$11,000,000 at this time special rules for city school districts require voter approval super majority consent of state comptroller and BOE regents. many districts get the waivers.
