# **State Funding Priorities**

In the Governor's Budget Address delivered on February 14, he outlined the need for the progressive income tax that 60% of Illinois voters will need to approve in November. There are some mixed messages coming out of the response. He did propose increasing EBF dollars by 350 million, however he would place in reserve 150 million pending the outcome of the tax vote.

# **Compliance Visit**

The Regional Office of Education will be in the District on Monday, March 16 to finish their compliance visit. Every 4 years, we go through this probe to examine our policies and practices to ensure they are congruent with the Illinois School Code.

## The Evidenced Based Funding Model and the Local Tax Rate

There continues to be much conversation in Illinois about the high rate of property taxes and the reliance local governments have on this type of tax. The EBF Model can be used to leverage what an appropriate rate for District #702 should be.

• Local Capacity Target (what we should expect locally): \$4,922,458

• Local Revenue (Real Receipts from all Local Sources): \$4,530,508

• Difference: \$391,950

Operating Rate for District #702: \$3.8713

According to the Formula it Should Be: \$4.2061

• About .35 cents short

#### COVID-19

Mr. Hinman met with local health departments and the Regional Office on March 12. There were a lot of discussions among superintendents at least locally about business as usual until there is at least a case in the area. We know this is going to happen. We have to balance our responsibilities to provide school with the knowledge prevention and/or mitigation can be an important role to play. Tremont Schools are staying open for now. There have been some cancellations of co-curriculars and the District will follow the Governor's guidelines, just announced tonight, for cancelling events of more than 250 attendees — beginning with the PTO's Daddy Daughter Dance on Saturday night. This is a rapidly changing situation. The administrative team is meeting March 13 to make sure we have everything in place for e-learning in an extended closure situation.
