- II. Academic Awards – List awards by the year received. Include things like honor roll, academic all-state, national merit competition, valedictorian or salutatorian awards, academic rank in class and GPA. You will receive **5 points** per listing for academic rewards.
  
- III. College or AP Courses – You will receive **two points** for each course listed. Please verify with a copy of your transcript.
  
- IV. Community Activities – List activities including church, volunteer work and community clubs (4-H, Scouts, etc.) by school year. Differentiate between high school and community activities. Be specific as you will receive **one point** per listing.
  
- V. Future Plans and Goals – In 500 words or less:
  - a. Explain your future goals and consider who has inspired you most to continue your education.
  - b. Describe a situation that you found challenging and how did you overcome it? What qualities did you discover about yourself?
  
- VI. How do you plan to finance your education?
