state funding and are exclusively locally funded projects.

WHEREAS, the aforementioned statutes authorize procedures, under the authority of the Commissioner of Education, which permit a board of education to transfer anticipated excess current revenue or unexpended appropriations into reserve accounts during the month of June by board resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Palmyra Board of Education wishes to deposit anticipated current year surplus into a capital reserve and maintenance reserve account at year end, and

WHEREAS, the Palmyra Board of Education anticipates current year surplus will be available for this purpose,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the School Business Administrator is hereby authorized to make a transfer of up to \$350,000 to capital reserve and a transfer up to \$300,000 to maintenance reserve consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.
