REGISTRATION INFORMATION 2023-2024

We are excited to announce Registration is open for the 2023-2024 school year! We ask that between August 7 and August 21, you follow the online instructions below. There will not be an in-person Registration so please take advantage of this convenience.

Using a tablet or computer, log in with your username (your last name) and the password is your established JMC parent portal password. If you have forgotten your password, please contact [Patrick Freeman](#) at the Elementary if your child is an elementary student and [Jake Scandrett](#) at the high school if your child is in high school.

ONLINE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Log into **23-24 School Year JMC parent portal** by **August 21**. Click the "Register for 2023-2024" on the left side menu of the Home page. Follow the prompts to review and edit your contact information and review emergency contact information.
 2. You will complete all questions for all of your enrolled children. Enrolled means any child receiving services from Murray County Central – Grades Jr. K through 12, Little Rebels, and Early Childhood Special Education students.
 3. Follow the prompts and when your progress bar reaches 100% you will land on the 'Finished' screen. There you will find links to three required items to complete your online registration.
 - a. Digital equity questionnaire, which is required by the State of Minnesota.
 - b. [Annual Health Form](#): Please complete for EACH student in your household.
 - c. MCC's computing agreement that requires a parent/guardian signature.
- If you select 'Yes' to the question of NEW health issues, the Health Office will reach out to you for details.
- If you select 'Yes' to the question of changes in your housing situation, Nikki Cheskie will contact you for more information.
- Class lists will be available at MCC's fair booth and on our website mid-August.

Additionally, you can click on Lunch to make a Family Lunch Deposit. These funds will allow your child(ren) to purchase Ala carte items like extra sides, entrees and milk (Grades 7-12 only). There will be no charge for breakfast or lunch this school year, but you are responsible for any other purchases by your child. There is a 40-cent charge for milk if your child is having milk only.

You may also choose to visit the Tuition / Fees link to Purchase Items. You can select your child's name from the drop down and then add items to your cart - Activity Fees and Class Dues, for example. You can add items for multiple children and make one payment using a credit or debit card or even your bank account.

We appreciate the time it takes to register for school and are definitely looking forward to seeing students this Fall.
