(Except May 30 & July 4th)

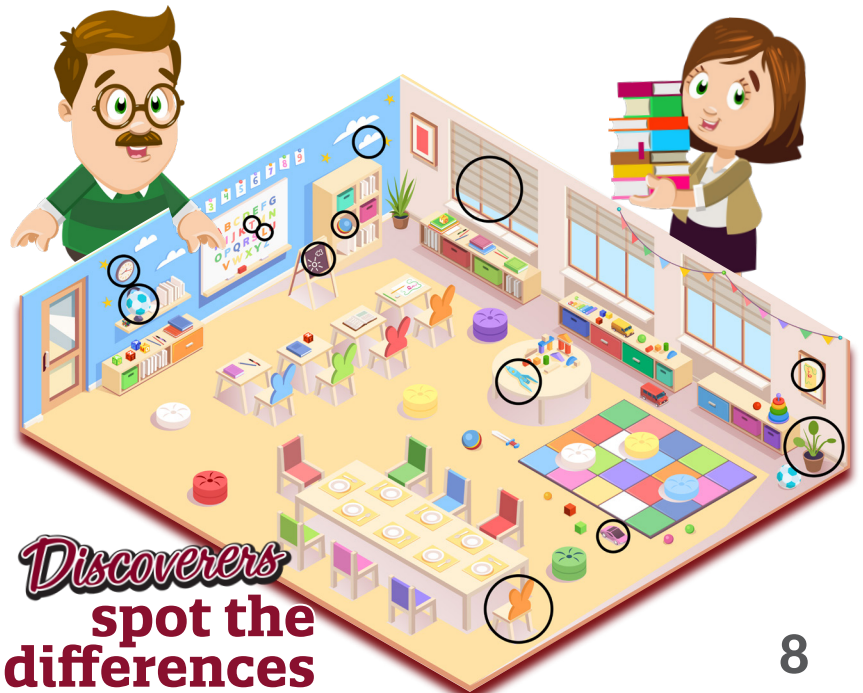
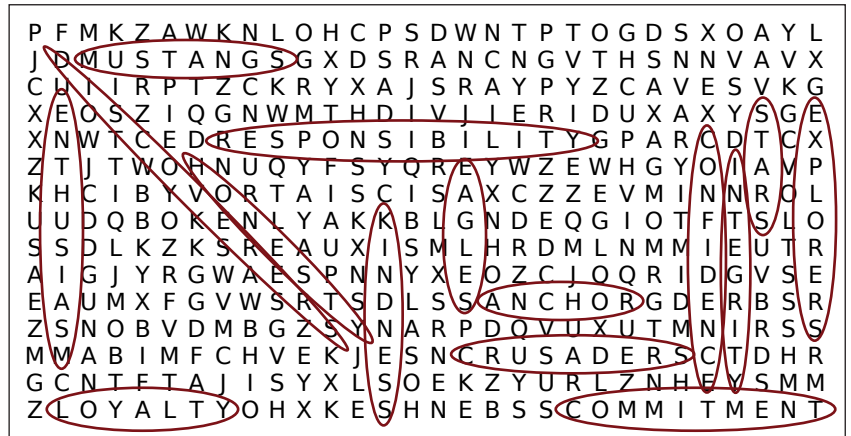
There is **NO COST** for children, ages 0-18,
