### **FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL**

- Thursday September 1st, 2022
- School Hours are from 8:55 am to 3:25 pm
- Pre K AM class 8:55-11:25 am, Pre K PM class 12:55-3:25 pm
- Students arrive no earlier than 8:40 am and no later than 9:05 am to ensure they are not marked tardy and or reported absent. An automated attendance system will go out notifying parents.
- To ensure the safety of your child please contact the office and their teacher ahead of time for any/all changes to your child's schedule. Please provide everything in writing as well for documentation.
- All guests must sign in the lobby & report to the office

### **SCHOOL DISMISSAL**

- Begins at 3:25 pm
- Parents picking up their child will be in our designated school pick up line.
- All cars picking up their child at the end of the day must have their child Pick-Up Tag displayed with proper identification. You will receive a new 2022-23 Parent Pick-Up Hang Tag & Child Backpack Tag during your Teacher Meet & Greet and/or on the first day of school
- Any/All changes to dismissal procedures or to the course of their day resulting in your child leaving the school early must be corresponded through the main office and their teacher to ensure the safety of your child.
- We ask that dismissal prior to 3:25 pm should only be done under extreme circumstances with written permission. Otherwise this causes class interruption, confusion and delays.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

- Please encourage your child/children to ride the school bus. This helps facilitate regular routine and further independence.
- A schedule for the Bus transportation and routes will be released soon to view on the
  district websites for parents. All kids will be assigned a school bus or van regardless if
  they are planning to take it or not. Without prior/proper school notification, this is how
