SUPERVISES:	All Building personnel in the absence of the Principal but does not perform evaluations.
JOB GOAL:	To provide leadership and managerial oversight of safe school operations during the absence of the building principal.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Current certified teaching staff member in the Old Bridge School District.
- 2. New Jersey Principal Certificate of Eligibility.
- 3. Experience as determined to be appropriate by the Board of Education.
- 4. History of adhering to district policies and procedures.
- 5. Demonstrated successful classroom management and instructional capabilities.
- 6. Strong Interpersonal and communication skills.
- 7. Participate in basic field training.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITES:

- 1. Assumes responsibility of the management of the school in accordance with law, administrative code, board policies, and regulations.
- 2. Maintains a safe and secure school and an effective learning environment.
- Reports all concerns or inconsistencies with law, administrative code, board policies, and regulations to the superintendent or assistant superintendent and building principal.
- 4. Conducts regular building checks throughout the day to ensure the safe operation of the school.
- 5. Maintains the high standard of student conduct and enforces discipline when necessary in accordance with board policy and the students' right to due process.
- 6. Notifies immediately the parent or guardian and the chief school administrator to arrange for an immediate examination by a physician of

any student suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or other drugs or of using anabolic steroids.

- 7. Maintains CPR certification
- 8. Performs all other duties which may be assigned or required by law, code, regulation, and board policy.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Per diem rate to be consistent with the terms established by the agreement between the Board of Education and the Old Bridge Education Association.

Persons with mental or physical disabilities are eligible as long as they can perform the essential functions of the job after reasonable accommodation is made to their known limitations. If the accommodation cannot be made because it would cause the employer undue hardship, such person may not be eligible.
