TITLE: Executive Director of Educational Programs

REPORTS TO: Superintendent/Assistant Superintendent

SUPERVISES: Supervisors, Child Study Team (CST) members, out-of-district placements, and related Secretarial/Clerical staff, other certificated and support employees as assigned.

JOB GOAL: To provide leadership and managerial oversight to district educational programs and to coordinate and supervise all activities related to identifying students with special needs, to develop and implement appropriate academic programs and services as required by federal, state, or local special education statutes, codes, and/or policies. To maintain positive relationships with the school community.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. New Jersey Administrative Certificate with Principal or School Administrator Endorsement or Certificate of Eligibility.
2. Experience as determined to be appropriate and sufficient by the Board of Education. Oversight / supervision of Special Education staff and services, teaching experience at the elementary and/or secondary level, and building-level administrative experience preferred.
3. Demonstrated leadership skills in the areas of curriculum development and program evaluation; staff development and school improvement.
4. Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
5. Required criminal history background check and proof of U.S. citizenship or legal resident alien status; proof of New Jersey residency unless exempt.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Plans, develops, and implements special services assignments and activities to meet district goals and legal mandates.
2. Supervises and evaluates the district supervisors, as well as other certified and non-certified staff as required or assigned.

3. Determines and recommends staffing needs, assists in recruitment, interviewing, selection, and orientation of the staff members.
4. Prepares and oversees the annual budget in consultation with the School Business Administrator for the Department of Special Services, Child Study Team, Out of District tuition, Federal IDEA programs.
5. Oversees all IEP's and their implementation, including all out of district placements, facilities, and programs for those students in need of specialized programs not available in the district, ensuring that each child is placed in the least restrictive environment as mandated by law.
6. Works in a positive manner with the board attorneys involved in the mediation process resulting from IEP and/or placement disputes and serves as principle resource in preparing for and defending against all Due Process hearings when mediation fails.
7. Serves as the district "Section 504 Coordinator" and the Homeless liaison.
8. Oversees and administers the district Home Instruction program.
9. Oversees and administers the district Speech program.
10. Oversees and administers the district PT and OT programs, whether in-house or outsourced.
11. Oversees and administers the district Pre-school Disabled and integrated preschool program.
12. Adheres to all state guidelines and time frames when preparing the annual state special education plan and any other special education related reports as may be required by the district.
13. Assist in the development of disciplinary guidelines designed to promote appropriate student behavior for students of all abilities.
14. Plans and implements regular staff meetings and in-service programs designed to encourage professional growth.
15. Keeps staff, central office, and the board informed and updated on matters related to current and future changes to the laws, codes, and policies affecting special education students, programs, requirements, and district responsibilities.

16. Recommends and oversees outsourced consultants as may be needed by the district.
17. Ensures district compliance with all mandated student record maintenance and privacy requirements.
18. Serves as the chief building administrator of the CST facility, when assigned and makes certain that said facility and related equipment is appropriately and safely used and maintained.
19. Works, meets, and maintains ongoing dialogue with professional, parent, and community groups, including the Special Education PTA (SEPTA) to foster understanding of and support for school programs.
20. Follows district regulations, policies, and procedures related to students, staff and programs including timelines inclusion on an agenda.
21. Oversees the Paraprofessional staff district-wide.
22. Ensures the prompt submission of time sheets to the payroll department.
23. Assists and advises the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent of Schools in developing and informing the school leadership teams.
24. Serves as a member of the top management team charged with the responsibility for planning, implementing, and assessing an educational program relevant to the needs of the student population in each school and the school district as a whole.
25. Serves as a resource person for information in matters of curriculum, instruction, and teaching methods and materials.
26. Provides articulation among elementary, middle, and high school administration regarding programs and curricula at each of those levels.
27. Coordinates with Assistant Superintendent of Schools on the implementation of professional evaluation activities and procedures so as to complement and improve overall instruction and student performance.

28. Assists the Superintendent in the determination of the resource allocation and the levels of services according to established policy: supervision of the preparation and execution of the budget for all instructional programs.
29. Attends all regular meetings of the Board of Education; prepares board reports and presents reports to the board.
30. Promotes the district's mission, philosophy, and vision. Builds internal/external partnerships that support district goals and enhance students learning.
31. Advances the district's professional image. Maintains open/effective communications. Uses problem-solving techniques to tactfully address and resolve questions/concerns.
32. Performs other duties, which may be assigned or required by law, code, regulation and board policy.

EMPLOYMENT:

Salary and work year consistent with the terms established by the Agreement between the Board of Education and the Old Bridge Directors' Association.
