### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Educational Facilities Manager certificate per N.J.S.A. 18A:17-50 (unless exempt)
- 2. Bachelor's Degree in Mechanical or Civil Engineering a plus
- 3. Required criminal history background check, proof of U.S. citizenship or legal resident alien status, and proof of New Jersey residency (unless exempt)
- 4. Five (5) years of experience in commercial/industrial construction, project management and/or facilities management with at least three (3) years in a supervisory capacity preferred.

**REPORTS TO:** School Business Administrator/Board Secretary

**SUPERVISES:** Maintenance, field, buildings and grounds, including employees and

contracted custodial staff, clerical and other District staff as assigned, as

well as other outside contractors and related vendors.

**JOB GOAL:** To ensure that the District's school buildings and grounds are maintained

in a safe, clean, and healthy manner and to ensure that the District is in compliance with all federal, state and local related laws, codes, Polices and

regulations.

### PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Recruit, interview, check references, and recommend hiring of maintenance, field, and custodial employees to the Superintendent or designee.
- 2. Assists in the recruitment and hiring of all supervisory level buildings and grounds employees.
- 3. Establish and maintain training programs for all buildings and grounds staff.
- 4. Oversee the evaluation of buildings and grounds staff in consultation with building administrators and other related supervisory staff.
- 5. Maintain records of staff attendance and exercise and enforce the District's attendance policies as appropriate.

- 6. Manage contracted cleaning services, including providing periodic inspections of the sites and written evaluations to the contractors and Central Administration.
- 7. Assist in the development, alteration, and maintenance of the District's Long-Range Facility Plan and maintains the District's Five (5) Year Maintenance Plan.
- 8. Conduct inspections of the District's buildings and grounds on a regular basis and report observations and conditions to Central Administration and to appropriate building administrators, as needed.
- 9. Maintain and update school/building cleaning assignments.
- 10. Responsible for entering and maintaining the data in the District's Work Order system, preventative maintenance program, and ensuring that supplies and materials are ordered and stored in a timely and secure fashion, that effective inventory controls are in place, and that needed work is performed and completed, whether by District staff or contracted services, in a timely, efficient, and correct manner.
- 11. Submits monthly reports to Central Administration concerning entered, outstanding, and completed Work Orders and projects, as well as on the progress and recommendations of outside firms performing services for the District.
- 12. Assists the Purchasing Department in determining specifications for supplies, equipment, and materials needed and oversees the distribution and inventory of related supplies, equipment, and materials.
- 13. Directs District-wide snow removal operations, including the assignment of District staff and the utilization and deployment of contracted services.
- 14. Advises the superintendent on building, parking lot, and road conditions for decisions on school closing during inclement weather.
- 15. Assists in the formation of the annual school budget providing input and recommendations including staffing, supplies, equipment, maintenance and capital projects.
- 16. Ensure District compliance with all environmental regulations, including but not limited to Employee's Right to Know, Blood Borne Pathogens, Asbestos Management/Abatement Requirements, and EPA Regulations, including those pertaining to Sewerage and Water Treatment Plants, Indoor Air Quality Assessments and Lead Water Testing Program, as well as state regulations and documentation regarding the operation and maintenance of low-pressure boilers and emergency electric generators.

- 17. Ensure District compliance with all safety and health requirements promulgated by controlling Agencies, including the Fire, Health, and Building Departments, Recycling agencies, and various District Insurance providers.
- 18. Work cooperatively with the various Offices of Emergency Management and emergency response agencies to develop and maintain plans for utilizing District facilities as emergency shelters as may be required.
- 19. Assist in the development and maintenance of an Action Plan to satisfy the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
- 20. Serves as the District designated official for the asbestos management plan as required by AHERA.
- Cooperates with building administrators in identifying substandard classrooms and develops plans for upgrading said classrooms in order to meet Department of Education standards.
- 22. Consults with and serves as liaison to the District Architect on school, facility, and/or site improvement, construction, or modification projects and develops plans and specifications for projects that are not assigned to the District Architect and Engineer.
- 23. Serves as the Clerk of the Works for all District building and site projects.
- 24. Performs other duties that may be within the scope of his/her employment as may be assigned by the Superintendent under the authority of the Board of Education.

### TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:
