SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM CHILD CARE CENTERS AND LOCATIONS

The District shall provide transportation to any child attending grades kindergarten through eight between the school a child legally attends and a New York State licensed child day care center located within the District or an unlicensed child care location provided that the unlicensed child care location is located within the child's school attendance zone, provided that the Center site and/or the unlicensed child care location meets the distance eligibility limits established by the District.

The distance used to determine the eligibility for such transportation service shall be measured from the curb site of the day care location to a point where the bus drops off students at the school the student legally attends.

An exception to the unlicensed day care transportation to cross other attendance zones will be at the discretion of the Superintendent or designee, provided that a hardship condition can be presented to the District by the parent/guardian, in writing, within the time limits for notification as set forth below.

Child care will only be offered on a five (5) day a week basis, both a.m. and p.m., to and from the child care location, but only when the District is open and students are present.

To receive such transportation services, a written request must be received from a parent/guardian of each student desiring to be transported by April 1 of the school year preceding the transportation need. For students moving into the District, a written request for transportation must be filed within thirty (30) calendar days after the parent/guardian establishes residency in the District.
