

B.W. CASSEDAY, DAYTON CHEMICALS, INC. SCHOLARSHIP

To a student of Vocational Agriculture of Dayton High School

We are very pleased to announce that B.W. Casseday, Dayton Chemicals, Inc. has made available an annual \$500.00 college scholarship to be awarded to a promising young man or woman of Dayton High School to be used during his/her first year's work in a college of Agriculture of his/her choice or vocational study. The donor asks that it be awarded to a Senior interested in the further study of agriculture with preference to those planning to study Agronomy. Students planning a vocational career are encouraged to apply.

The award is to be made to this year's graduating senior on the basis of character, desire to study agriculture, financial need, scholarship, and a record of achievement as shown by the person's activity in FFA, high school clubs and organizations, community activities, church, etc.

The primary objective of this scholarship is to encourage worthy boys or girls in a future study of Agriculture. Each scholarship is for \$500.00 and will be presented annually. In the event that the selection committee feels that there are no qualified applicants, the scholarship may be withdrawn until the following year.

First payment will be made to the boy or girl within two weeks after he/she has completed enrollment in a college of agriculture. The second and final payment will be made after the boy or girl satisfactorily completes his/her first semester and made proper enrollment for the second. In the event that the college attended is on the quarter basis, the payments will be divided in three parts of \$166.66 each quarter.

Submit the following materials in the order that they appear on the list:

1. Application for State FFA Degree. (It is desirable to have attained the degree but not a necessary qualification.) - Optional
2. A picture of the contestant and one or more of his/her Supervised Farming program mounted on an 8 1/2" x 11" sheet of paper.
3. A 300 word theme in his/her own handwriting on the subject, "Why I am interested in a further study of agriculture."
4. Transcript of high school grades.
5. Letters of recommendation from persons who know of the character, need, record of achievement, etc., of the applicant. (Not less than three and not more than five should be submitted.)
