Game Expectations for Students



SOMETHING NEW!!

Future Jackets – Any student in grades PK-6 can be accompanied by a parent onto the field before a home football game. They will meet in front of the helmet and will be able to run through the helmet. Parents will pick them up on the other side of the field and escort their students off.

Kermit High School athletes enjoy positive support from their fellow students, parents, and the community. The support of fans attending high school football games is evidence of the enthusiastic pride we have in our schools and our student athletes. We continue to welcome elementary and Junior High students to the high school games and want to create the best possible circumstances for their safety, as well as for our high school students and other event guests.

In an effort to maintain a safe and orderly environment at our home events, and so that all fans can enjoy the games; we are asking your support for the following practices:

Elementary Students

- MUST be accompanied by an adult in order to gain entrance into the stadium. The student must sit with the accompanying adult. This change is being made to improve safety for the students. It is important that school personnel managing the event have the ability to contact an adult on site, if necessary.

Secondary Students – Student Sections

- Students entering into the stadium on an athletic pass will be required to enter through the **North** gate. If entering on an Athletic Pass, students are required to sit in student section. Students will be required to produce their athletic pass or they must buy a ticket.
- Any secondary student who does not enter with an adult will be required to sit in student section.
- Junior High section will be seated in the third section away from the band.
- High School section is the section next to the band. Any student who is enrolled in Junior High and High School may sit in their perspective areas.
- Dress code is enforced for anyone who enters on an athletic pass and /or sitting in student section.
- Any student entering with an athletic pass will be given an armband.
- Concessions and bathrooms should be accessed before the game. All students should be in their section by kick off. Students must remain in student section until released for a bathroom / concession stand break during the middle of half time. All students will be required to return to the student section at the end of the third quarter.
- Any student needing to call for a ride must call at the beginning of the 4th quarter.

General Expectations for All

- Anyone wearing a mask, suit, etc. that conceals a person's identity will not be allowed entrance.
- No re-entry. If a student leaves the stadium, they will not be allowed to re-enter.
- Outside food and drinks will not be allowed.
- All spectators are expected to be in stadium seats to cheer for our team as they enjoy the game.
- Stairways, walkways and the rails of the stands must be kept open.

- Always exhibit good sportsmanship: (Be respectful during the National Anthem, school songs, and player introductions. Never boo or yell at officials or opposing players. Cheer for the Kermit players. Represent Kermit in a positive manner.)
- No football games or similar type of activities either in the stands or below the stands that would encourage running and throwing of objects. This is for everyone's safety.

Possible Consequences for consistent misbehavior

- May be taken to an accompanying adult to sit for the remainder of the game,
- May be asked to leave the stadium for the event,
- May be asked to not to return to any extra-curricular event for the academic year, and
- Students may be given a discipline referral,
