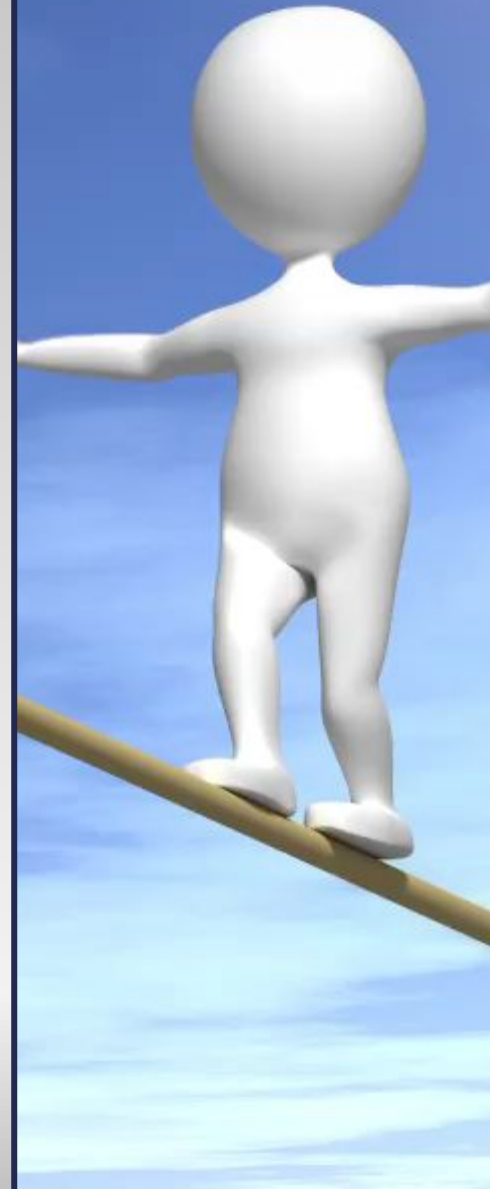

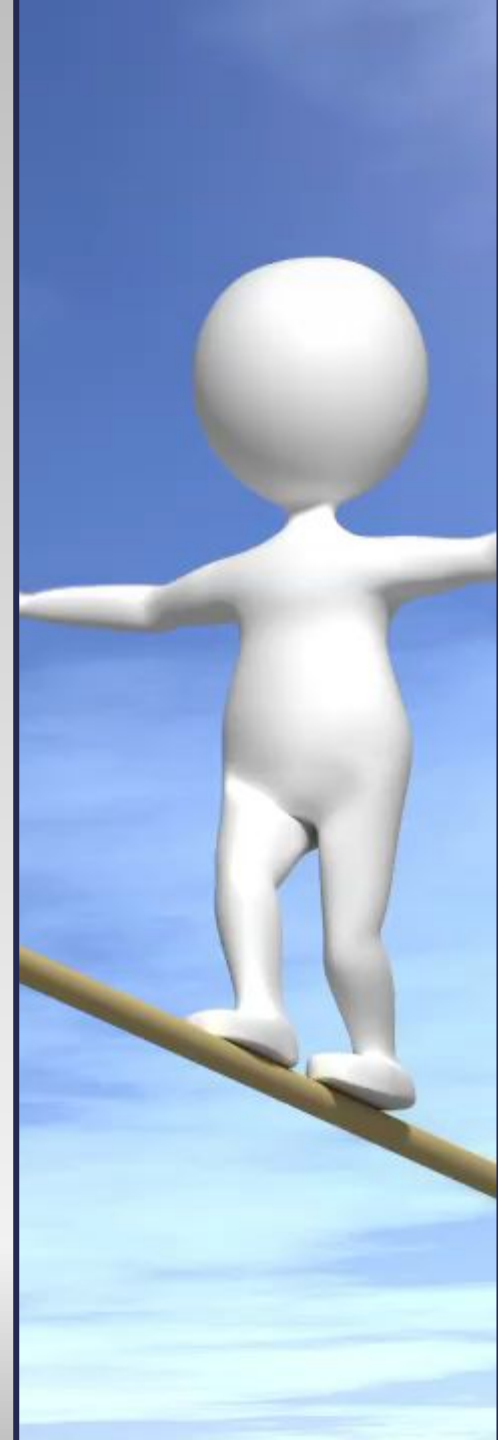

Awarded District Grants

Education and Workforce Innovation Fund grant

- The N.C. Education and Workforce Innovation Commission
- The grant program is aimed at developing innovative programs that will lead to more students graduating career and college ready.
- Leverage partnership with regional businesses and business leaders to foster innovation in education that combines academic rigor and skills development.
- Competitive grant
- Awarded \$60,000 for 2019-20 and 2020-21
(Total: \$120,000 two-year grant cycle)



Awarded District Grants

AT&T and AT&T Foundation / Non-profit organization

- AT&T and the AT&T Foundation support projects that create opportunities, make connections, and address community needs where we live and work.
- Competitive grant
- Awarded 4 AWiFiRanger Teton LTE (C-19)
 - Standalone connectivity solution for vehicles as the router can connect to both WiFi and LTE.
 - The Teton LTE (C-19) can be powered from a DC accessory outlet within the school bus.
 - The WiFi signal will cover a 1/2 mile radius from the device.
- We are in the process of reviewing the Warren County map to determine the placement of the AWiFiRanger Teton LTE (C-19).

AFJROTC Unit at Warren County High School



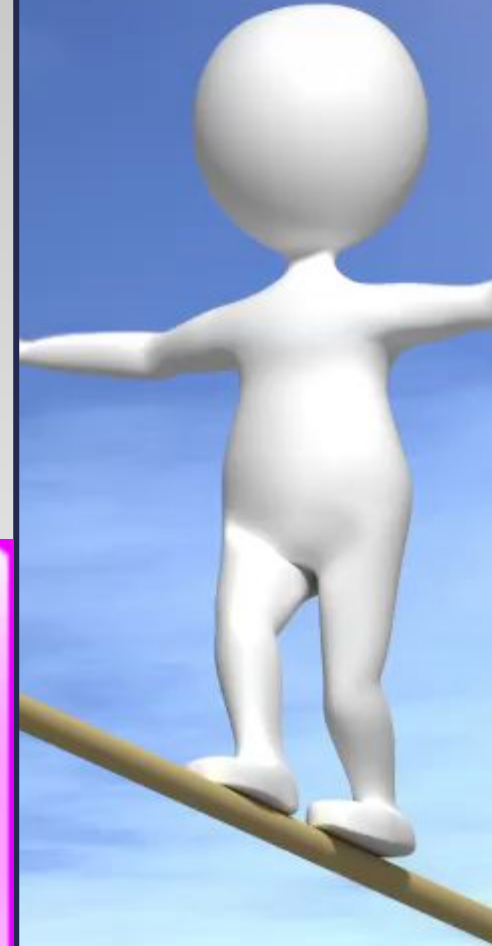
- NC 200612 AFJROTC Unit has earned the Distinguished Unit Award.

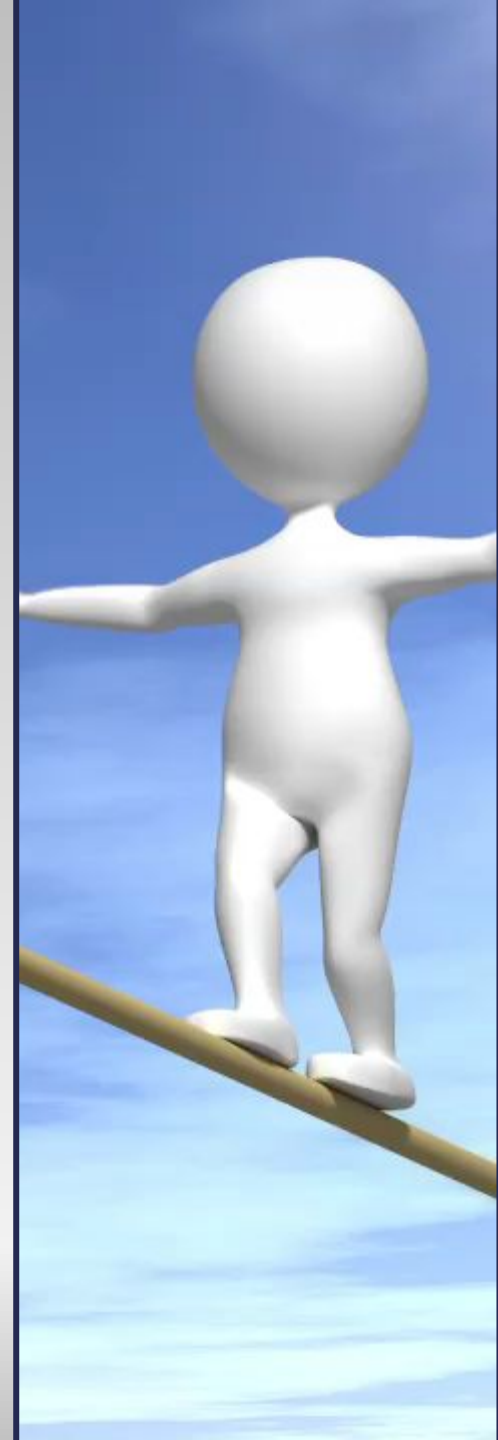
High School Senior Graduation

 - The information will be distributed by schools.



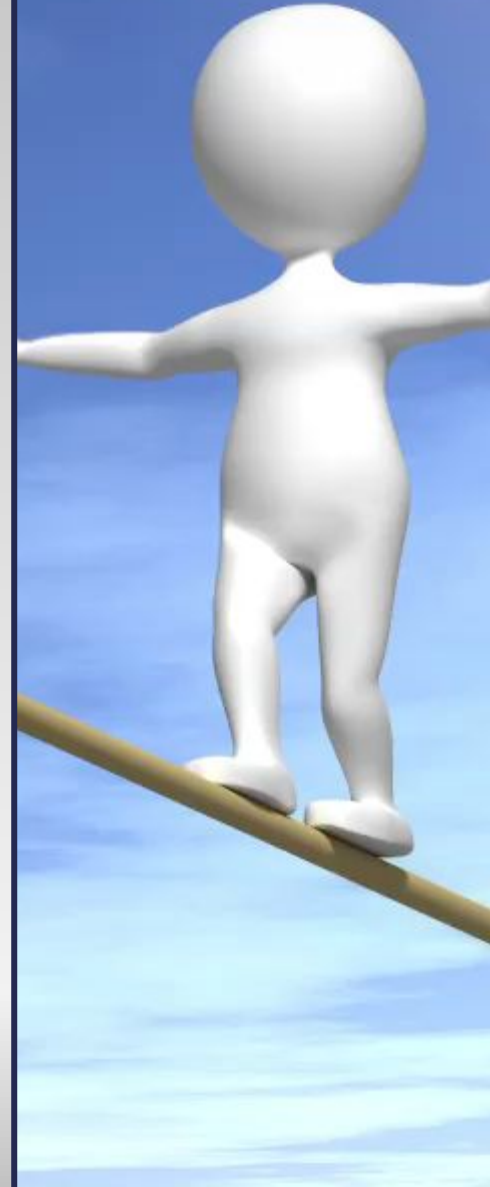
District Summer Schedule
