May 11-20 - Graduation

Seniors will be assigned a specific day and a 15-minute time slot to report to the auditorium in their cap and gown. **IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU ARRIVE ON TIME.** Entrance will be at the auditorium doors ONLY. During this time, a photo will be taken of the senior, dressed in their cap/gown, on the stage, with diploma cover in hand. The graduate will receive their envelope containing their diploma and other important documents. Each graduate will receive a program, a ticket (for souvenir), a photo with diploma, a group photo of graduating class (photoshopped), and a video DVD of the ceremony. This photo/video activity is necessary to create and complete the entire ceremony, which will be aired at a watch (from home) party tentatively scheduled for May 29. We will let you know the final date and time. Please read and note the specific instructions below.

In accordance with the guidelines as set forth by the State of Kentucky, we **MUST** maintain proper social distancing during this event. Social distancing guidelines during this pandemic are considered by households. Therefore, the graduates will be allowed members of their household to accompany them inside the school with a maximum **limit of six** individuals in addition to the graduate. This allows us to meet the rule limiting groups to 10 or less and is about the same number of tickets a graduate would receive if having the traditional ceremony in the auditorium. All guests will be asked to wear a face mask and gloves. If you already have those feel free to wear your own but those who do not have this personal protective equipment (PPE) will have it provided by the school. Those who may be more at risk or do not feel well, should remain at home. These measures are being put into place to help prevent the potential spread of the virus by asymptomatic carriers. By wearing masks and gloves, we are able to reduce the time necessary for precautionary cleaning and reduce the time necessary to create and complete this special life memento.

Arrival times will be scheduled for you and you must follow the schedule as provided. There will be cones designating parking spaces just outside the auditorium doors on the New Lair Road side of the building. The coned spaces will accommodate 2 parking spaces for each senior so we ask that you limit your party to 2 vehicles. Spaces will be designated and available as current time slot and then on deck for the next time slot. There will be a third designated space for the next senior/family, which will move into one of the primary two parking spaces as those before you leave and spaces become available. Senior/family should arrive together if using multiple cars (again no more than 2) so they may be staged for quick ingress and egress to and from the building. Please arrive on time but not more than 15 minutes early. You **MUST** remain inside your vehicles until your scheduled time. You will enter a designated door at the auditorium foyer and exit a designated door. As you enter there will be a sanitary station for masks/gloves for those family members who need them. Seniors will visit the honors table for any last minute cords, etc. From there, the family will follow their senior into the auditorium for the filming/photo event. When finished, you will exit a different door into the lobby, where you will receive a packet of information and parting measures specific to each senior. After completing this final step you must go directly to your vehicle and depart creating space/room for the next on-deck senior and their family. IF you cannot come at your scheduled time, you must let Ms. Nichols or Ms. Posey know immediately, not later than May 1. Understandably, this is a huge undertaking, involving 219 graduates, so please make every effort to be here when assigned.
