**CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT CONTRACT**

Jones High School is pleased to offer junior and senior students the opportunity to earn college credit through the concurrent enrollment program. In this program, students are enrolled in college classes through Rose State College. They attend the class at Jones High School. In this setting, the class is conducted over the Internet using H.323 technology. This is real-time, two-way, interactive teaching. You might think of it like video conferencing.

As these are college courses, they meet only every other day. These schedules are different from our daily high school schedule. These students are taking on added responsibility, and by doing that deserve some additional freedoms. The following is a contract listing what I feel are fair guidelines. My philosophy here is that as long as students perform at above-average standards, they will be allowed above-average privileges.

1. The student must maintain a “B” or better average in every class.
2. The student must not be absent more than four (4) days per twelve (12) week period.
3. The student must remain in good overall standing with minimal discipline issues.

As long as the above standards are met and the parent agrees, the student will be allowed to account for their own time when not scheduled to meet with the class. At any time, the student may be required to report to “study hall” when the class is not in secession.
