Programming will be offered through three 45-50 minute morning video meetings with lots of hands-on, fun activities developed and led by great instructors. All youth who participate will receive a weekly activities pack delivered to them with supplies - arts and crafts, food for our virtual "cooking classes," STEM projects, plants for your garden and lots of other materials.
