The Principal is the educational leader and chief executive of his/her assigned building. The Principal is responsible for the total educational experience of the students at his/her school and is to provide the leadership and coordination that will encourage the staff, students and parents to work together toward the best possible school program in conformity with Board policies. The Principal shall be responsible for management and evaluation of staff, maintenance of facilities and equipment, administration of the educational program, overall supervision of the students attending his/her school, management of his/her school's budget, and communication between his/her school and the community.

The Principal shall act with the approval of the Superintendent and shall exercise authority delegated to him/her and necessary to carry out the duties of the position.

The Principal shall have an appropriate valid Illinois license. The Principal's duties shall be delineated in a written job description.
