Business - Security of Buildings, Equipment and Grounds

The Superintendent shall establish such rules and regulations as may be necessary to provide proper building security. Such rules and regulations shall include, but not be limited to:

- 1. Minimizing fire hazards.
- 2. Reducing the probability of faulty equipment.
- 3. Guarding against the chance of electrical shock.
- 4. Keeping records and funds in a safe place.
- 5. Protecting against vandalism and burglary.
- 6. Safeguarding building security and access, including
 - a. deterrence,
 - b. detection,
 - c. delay, and
 - d. response.
