For involvement in the total educational process, teachers should have well-defined and accessible lines of communication to the administration and Board. The District, through the Superintendent, will provide teachers with the opportunity to participate in the planning and evaluation of a school's educational activities.

The Board recognizes and expects that teachers will need to complete tasks that extend beyond the normal school day including but not limited to:

- 1. grading papers and tests,
- 2. developing lesson plans,
- 3. meeting with individual students and/or parents,
- 4. participating in curriculum development/evaluation, and
- 5. contributing to other District-wide educational efforts.
