A substitute teacher shall be a person qualified to instruct in District schools and who is employed for short periods of time in the absence of the regular teacher. They must hold either a valid teaching license or substitute license and shall be subject to the limits placed on substitute teachers by the Illinois School Code and, if applicable, the Illinois Teachers' Retirement System (TRS).

Suitable training, orientation, and evaluation of the work of substitute teachers shall be the responsibility of the professional staff under the direction of the Superintendent.

Rates of compensation for substitute teachers shall be set by the Board.

Substitute teachers shall not participate in the health and welfare plans or other fringe benefits of the District.
