Tutoring is defined as providing instructional assistance for pay to students in a particular curriculum area.

The Superintendent shall establish rules to protect the District from legal liability and the teachers from charges of conflict of interest when tutoring services are provided. These rules shall include at a minimum the following limits on tutoring:

- 1. Tutoring is not allowed on District property unless a release signed by the student's parent has been received.
- 2. District employees who either currently assess or may be in a position in the future to assess a student are not permitted to provide paid tutoring to that student.
