- OVER INCOME GUIDELINE FULL PAY STUDENTS NEED TO SET UP AN ACCOUNT IN TITAN TO MAKE <u>PAYMENTS FOR MEALS IN TITAN.</u>

Meals need to be paid for prior to service. Please make sure your child has a positive balance in their account. **Make payments to your student(s) accounts through your TITAN account online.** If you need assistance making your payment on line, or if that is not an option for you, please contact the school for assistance.

**UNPAID MEAL BALANCES:** Dufur School will make reasonable efforts to collect unpaid meal charges classified as delinquent debt. <u>Negative balances not paid prior to the end of the month</u> will be turned over to the Superintendent or their designee for collection. Options for collection may include collection agencies, small claims court or any other legal method permitted by law.
