

## Attention parents of Young Children Early Childhood Screening March 7 & 8, 2023

The East Grand Forks School District, in accordance with State law, is sponsoring Early Childhood Screening for all children <u>3 to 5 years of age by March 6, 2023</u>. Screening will be held <u>March 7 & 8</u>, 8:00-7:30 PM. If your child is enrolled at Head Start you do not need to participate, your child has already been screened at Head Start.

- A child only needs to complete screening <u>once</u> before entering kindergarten.
- All MN residents and open enrolled students of School District #595 are welcome to attend at no cost to the family.
- This screening is required for entrance into Kindergarten and School Readiness Preschool.
- Screening should be completed when a child is <u>3 to 4 years old</u>.
- The purpose of screening is to guarantee that all young children in Minnesota are well equipped and ready for learning.
- Only Minnesota residents are eligible to be screened.

Appointments are scheduled every 20 minutes but you should plan to be at your appointment for 60-90 minutes.
