

MINUTES of a regular public meeting of the Board of Education of Community Consolidated School District Number 259, Kankakee and Iroquois Counties, Illinois, held in the Special Education Conference Room in the Lorenzo R. Smith Elementary School Building, 4120 South Wheeler Road, Hopkins Park, Illinois, in said School District at 6:00 o'clock P.M., on the 13th day of February, 2019.

The meeting was called to order by the President, and upon the roll being called, Tonia Thomas, the President, and the following members were physically present at said location: T. Thomas, J. Sneed, C. Butler, B. Casten,

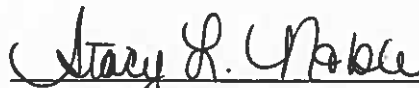
