

TENNIS COURT RENOVATION

The Tennis courts were identified by the Prescott community in 2012, when the Port of Walla Walla came to Prescott looking for projects that could be potentially funded through a grant. Unfortunately, as it turned out the grant funds could not be allocated to tennis court renovation.

Despite this setback, the Prescott School Board and community wanted to pursue the tennis court renovation. You may recall that the Waitsburg Times covered the project in an article back in November of 2015. The City of Prescott, Prescott Parks and Recreation as well as the Prescott Lions support the project.

In an effort to keep the costs of the project as low as possible, we contacted Alex Knopp a Senior Civil Engineering student at Walla Walla University to assist with the design specifications. In addition, the Prescott maintenance staff will perform as much of the demolition as possible. The chain link on the North side will remain standing in order to keep our students off Highway 124.

The Prescott School Board has earmarked capital project funds to complete this project. The start date for the project is tentatively set for June 1, 2018. We will call for bids this fall.
