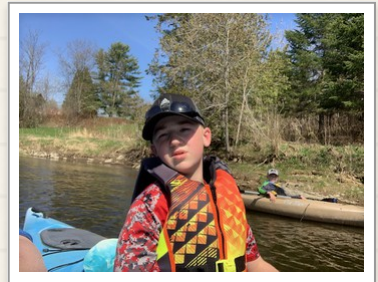
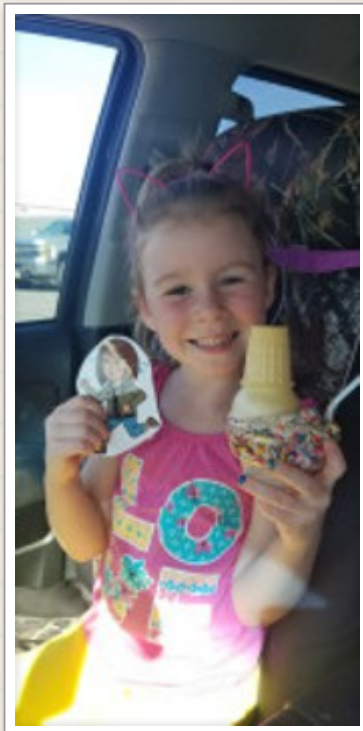
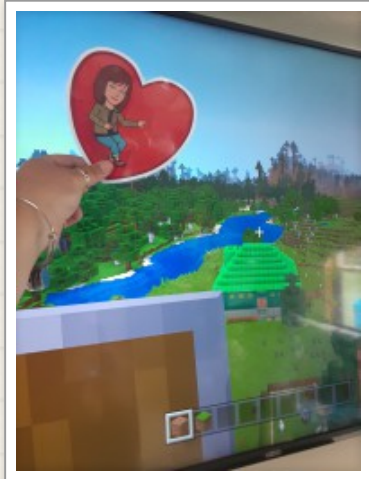
The last of the learning packets that were not picked up will be delivered with meals tomorrow, so if you don't receive meals please listen for the bus. Thank you!

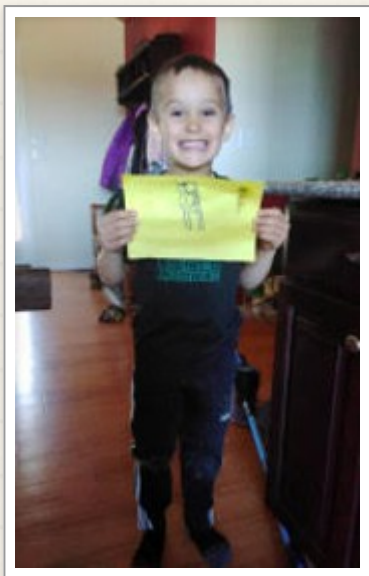
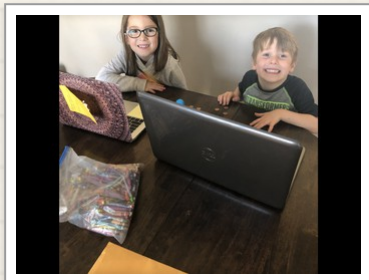
