Dear Parents and Guardians,

Next week is June and we will be starting our final 2.5 weeks of school. Each school has been in communication with their students and parents for end of year activities such as pick up and drop off on locker contents and school materials. They are also communicating their plans for end of year award and commencement ceremonies. We have been holding out on finalizing plans for the Class of 2020 graduation in the hopes that we would be able to have as close to a traditional ceremony as possible. The closer we get to summer, the larger our concerns grow that we will not be able to do this.

Today, Gov. Lamont released new participant capacities for indoor and outdoor events. After July 6, the number of people participating/attending an outdoor graduation will be capped at 150 people. We await the release of the guidelines that will accompany the new cap. In the meantime, the high school administration and staff have been researching options. They have also surveyed the students, communicated with parents and have held a series of meetings with the Class of 2020 officers. We are working to have an announcement by the end of next week.


