Sledding Adventures

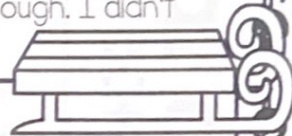


